Description

A WellSiteSentry Emergency Response Technician has the primary responsibility to provide specialized fire prevention, suppression and life safety services to Oil and Gas personnel, infrastructure and assets. WellSiteSentry crew members will be available 24/7/365 while occupying the WellSiteSentry Command Center on temporary assignments at Oil and Gas Well Sites. Employees are non-exempt, full time, hourly employees. Team members will be able to choose from several shift options in regard to the days and hours worked.

The Ideal candidate will be a leader, able to show initiative, inspire, motivate, be flexible, dependable, punctual, and accountable in every interaction, possess excellent judgment and problem solving skills and demonstrate the highest level of customer service.

Tasks:

- Responds to fires in a timely, safe and skilled manner, and participate in control of fires
- Quickly follows established Company procedures when responding to fire emergencies
- Correctly and promptly uses all relevant apparatus, tools, and equipment. Remains calm and poised in all emergency situations and gains rapid control over the problem at hand
- Rescues persons endangered by fires or other hazards, and administers first aid to injured parties as an EMT-B
- Quickly analyzes situations where life safety is threatened and applies the correct treatment
- Conducts company fire inspections and other fire prevention tasks on a frequent and timely basis, including fire safety education, to eliminate or reduce fire hazards and enforce fire codes
- Correctly applies fire codes in inspections. Conducts thorough inspections and accurately identifies violations
- Effectively utilizes appropriate educational approaches to fire prevention where needed
- Interviews and thoroughly and accurately examines patients for signs and symptoms related to the cause of the illness or injury
- Quickly and competently analyzes the medical emergency and applies the correct medical treatment approach as an EMT-B
- Assists in the maintenance of fire and rescue apparatus, tools, and equipment keeping such apparatus, tools, and equipment in good operating and safe condition by competently and efficiently performing maintenance and testing tasks
- Maintains knowledge about specific fire hazards on the Well Site and effective approaches for prevention and suppression
- Keeps the WellSiteSentry Command Center and related grounds, facilities, and supplies in a clean, orderly and usable condition

WellSiteSentry Emergency Response Technician Job Description

CORROSOURCE

- Performs routine non-firefighting work tasks willingly and adequately such as working on WellSiteSentry records and other documented information
- Able to meet the physical requirements required to perform firefighting tasks and life safety skills
- Remains skilled in and properly applies modern fire suppression tactics, methods, and procedures as well as emergency life-saving procedures through training drills
- Projects a positive image to the client as a emergency response service professional. Develops and maintains client support for fire suppression and fire prevention activities
- Abides by CORROSOURCE rules, regulations, policies, procedures, mission and guiding principles

Qualifications

Knowledge:

- Issues, problems, principles and practices of firefighting, fire prevention, emergency medical services, and fire apparatus operation and maintenance
- Relevant laws, ordinances, codes and court decisions that affect fire protection
- Fire hazards and firefighting resources
- Functions, characteristics, and proper use and maintenance of firefighting equipment and supplies
- Current laws and regulations pertaining to fire prevention and safety
- First aid, emergency medical care and rescue methods
- Incident Command System

Skills:

- Interpreting current laws, rules, and regulations pertaining to emergency medical services, fire prevention and safety
- Identifying hazardous conditions and obtaining code compliance with minimal technical support
- Maintaining firefighting and EMS equipment and fire station facilities
- Providing emergency medical services at the EMT-1 level
- Suppressing fires
- Communicating effectively with the clients

Abilities:

- Ability to use continuous and/or short bursts of muscle force to jump, sprint, climb ladders, pull victims out of hazardous areas
- Up and downstairs carrying equipment as required, lifting, pushing, pulling, or carrying objects using his/her hands, arms, back, abdominal muscles, shoulders, or legs
- Exert his/herself physically over a period of time without giving out
- Work effectively and safely during unavoidable exposure to an unpleasant environment with exposure to potentially heavy and somewhat unpredictable hazards
- Safely wear a self-contained breathing apparatus without medical or physical restriction
- Move his/her body quickly while keeping his/her balance on surfaces offering narrow footing
- Clearly see objects with vision meeting Company requirements
- Follow verbal and written instructions
- Effectively apply firefighting, rescue, and emergency medical techniques
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships
- Think and act quickly and competently in emergencies and under stress

Minimum Requirements:

All candidates MUST have clean background investigation and successfully pass an initial drug screening upon offer of employment. The following sections provide the minimum qualifications for positions in non-exempt categories.

DMV/EDUCATION

- Valid Driver's License
- Clean Driver's Record
- High School Diploma or GED

PHYSICAL FITNESS

- Work Capacity Test - Arduous Level (Pack Test)
- Pass full DOT physical: bending, pushing, pulling, crouching, and vision

FIRE

- Minimum Qualifications:
 - 18 years old
- Minimum Training Requirements:
 - Certificate of completion for a Firefighter 1 Academy OR
 - NWCG FFT2 (S-130, S-190, I-100, L-180) OR
 - Meets Requirements for NFPA 1001 OR
 - Military Firefighter Equivalent
